School Context:

Lake Munmorah P.S. (LMPS) is a PP2 school with approximately 530 students. There is a Principal, Deputy Principal, 4 Assistant Principals, 21 classes, a teacher librarian, a Support Teacher Learning, Reading recovery teacher, administrative and support staff. Following a NSW Government initiative in 2008 the school was awarded a Support Learning Coordinator who will be based at LMPS supporting both this and other schools in the Local Management Group. The school is committed to providing a quality learning environment where all students can reach their full potential. Students have the opportunity to take part in educational activities, a range of sporting opportunities and a variety of regional cultural activities.

School Evaluation:

School based assessment has included: community meetings, surveys, Stage assessments and NAPLAN Test results as well as discussions with teaching staff and the P&C. This evaluation indicated that:

- There is a need to review and refresh our teaching of Numeracy K-6.

- There is a need for the school to revisit and focus on the Quality Teaching Framework to ensure the engagement of all students at LMPS.
